VSI reinvested the money saved by not using the equivalent of 27 glass bottles, labels, corks, dividers and cardboard cartons into providing much higher quality wines in the PolyKeg®

- Fastest growing wine by sales in the US
- Naturally carbonated

Pinot Grigio - Italian/Veneto - 12% ABV

- Light fruit notes
- Balanced flavor profile
- Not too sweet, not too acidic

Chardonnay – Italian/Veneto – 12.5% ABV

- Light but pronounced fruit notes
- Appealing color and bouquet
- No "oaked" taste promotes a second glass

Cab-Blend – Italian – 13.5% ABV (80% Cab the rest Primitivo and Merlot)

VS Spanish Wines

Tempranillo Rose' - Spanish/ La Mancha - 12% ABV

- Attractive eye appealing color
- Light to medium fruit
- Mature flavor profile offers a crisp taste

Compared in quality/price 750 ml btl to: (a Rose' from the red Tampranillo Grape –very upscale like the "fine" French Rose's) Chateau d'Esclans Whispering Angel (France)- \$17.99-\$18.99

Tempranillo – Spanish – Red (La Mancha) – 13% ABV

- Rich, ruby color provides eye appeal
- Fruit-forward, full-bodied, dry finish
- Accompanies food well

Campo Viejo Grand Rereserva- \$ 18.99- \$19.99

Sangria – Spanish – Red (La Mancha) (Special permission to be 12.8% ABV)

- Spanish national drink, global appeal
- Aromatic seasoning, balance, faintly sweet
- Perfect base for adult beverage up-sell as cocktail, add Brandy or Rum

Compared in quality/price 750 ml btl to: \$ 12.99 but nothing to compare. VSI received special permission to have 12.8%ABV because in the US we use Ice in this drink. Sangria by law in Spain is only 6-7% ABV. We also used the Tempranillo Grape
